- 1550 Bus stop violation tickets issued for the year 2009
- 478 Bus stop violation tickets issued for the period January 1, 2009 – May 31, 2009
- 740 Bus stop violation tickets issued for the period January 1, 2010 – May 31, 2010
- 55% increase in violations issued by Transit Police Officers during the first five months of 2010, when compared to the same period for 2009
