# FFYs 2019 – 2023 TIP Evaluation Criteria

## Proposed Updates



What were the goals?	What did we do?
Create <b>repeatable</b> methodology	Worked with MPO staff and MassDOT to clarify how criteria should be applied
Define <b>all data</b> needs and sources	Connected each criteria to data source(s)
Clarify what we need from project proponents	Created project proponent guide and questionnaire
Simplify and organize our internal project database	Developing reorganized internal TIP database
Clearly communicate project scoring through online TIP database	Developing reorganized online TIP database

# What are the proposed changes?

## ➤ Equity

- ✓ Align MPO measures of equity with Federal guidance
- ✓ eliminate minimum population requirement

## ➤ Safety

- ✓ Align MPO measures of safety with the Commonwealth's average crash rates
- ✓ Create meaningful way to understand an area of above-average safety concern for the region

# What are the results?

- **Repeatable** methodology with clearly defined data needs and sources
- **Clear and Transparent** process
- **Minor change** in some project scores
